

# General Guidelines

The 2022 Curwood River Race is scheduled for Sunday, June 5.

Race begins at McCurdy Park in Corunna at 12pm

Kayaks will launch by 12:00pm

Canoes by 12:15pm

Rafts will start to be launched shortly after the canoes.

Kayaks and Canoes will be a speed race. Awards will be given out for those that pass under the foot bridge near the Castle quickest. Rafts will be judge on style, build and themes. They will be judged after crossing dam just north of M-21.

All paid participants pre-registered by May 15, 2022 will be guaranteed a race packet including a Curwood River Race shirt.

Kayaks and Canoes:

Pre-registration cost is \$20 per racer.

Registration after May 15, 2020 is \$25 per racer.

Rafts:

Pre-registration cost is \$50 per raft, includes 4 people, add \$10 per extra person.

Registration after May 15, 2020 is \$60 per raft, includes 4 people, add \$10 per extra person.

On-site registration the day of the event will start at 10:45am, race packets and shirts are not guaranteed for late registration.

## **Rules**

### **All Crafts:**

All participants must sign a waiver of liability form. Parents must sign for those under 18.

All participants must wear a life preserver and shoes for the race.

All crafts must be numbered and the participant's picture taken before the craft enters the water.

No engines or motors are permitted to move the craft or spray observers with forced water.

All participants must sign a waiver of liability form.

All crafts must be numbered and the participant's picture taken before the craft enters the water.

### **Rafts:**

Must use paddles, oars, or poles to move the raft along.

Rafts must be hand-built. Pre-made made craft are not permitted.
