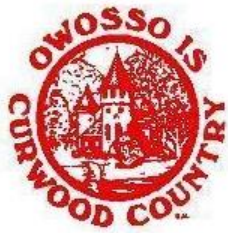

Security

Rules and Regulations

- There must be a responsible adult in your area at all times. The Curwood Festival and its volunteers will not be held liable for theft, injury or damage to property or persons while on the premises.
- Please keep your area neat and clean at all times.
- Please do not tear down your display before closing time. Vendors who leave early will not be invited to participate next year.
- A copy of current liability insurance must be included with your completed Marketplace application. The insurance coverage will be verified to ensure adequate coverage.
- The Curwood Festival's Marketplace does not accept personal or business checks. Your application must be accompanied by a money order or a certified bank check. No Exceptions.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages on public streets, parking lots, and the Marketplace area is not permitted.
- Your application is good for selling items from your booth space only. Individuals or vendors caught selling items from outside their allotted space will be asked to shut down completely and leave the festival area with no refund. This is not a permit for peddling products throughout the festival area.
- Exotic knives, swords, stars, spiked items, drugs, drug paraphernalia or sexually explicit items are strictly prohibited. NO EXCEPTIONS! Any standard pocket knife (blades not greater than 3" in length) that you may wish to sell needs approval by the Marketplace Chairman in advance of any sales. Vendors or individuals caught selling any of these prohibited items will be asked to shut down completely and leave the festival area with no refund.
- Vendors will only be allowed to display and sell the items described on your application as your selection for the Curwood Festival's Marketplace is based on this information.
- The Curwood Festival, Inc reserves the right to accept or reject any application. The vendors that are not accepted will have their application fees returned. Once a vendor is accepted the application fees will not be returned or refunded.
- Failure to comply with the above terms and local city ordinances may result in removal from the Curwood Festival's Marketplace without refund.
